1. INTRODUCTION

The Project Liaison Committee (PLC) for Contract SANRAL R.022-050-2012/1, hereby invites current and prospective Contractors that are registered as Military Veterans to apply to be registered on the Military Veteran Contractors Database. The database is intended to ensure that the companies registered will get tender notices and further assist to give contractors an indication of the available expertise for the Contractor to plan their training requirements.

The town of Kwa-Ngwanase is a gateway to Mozambique and a renowned tourist attraction area forming part of the world heritage park: Isimangaliso Wetland Park. The town is also the main business hub serving a population of about 500 000 people. Due to the town's rapid growth it has seen a significant number of businesses (formal and informal) being opened along Road R22. This has led to a significant decline in the level of service within the town.

The main challenges facing the town are listed below:

- Heavy delays through town due to illegal U-turns and parking on the road;
- Poor access to the hospital and clinic;
- Delivery trucks parking on the road;
- Damage to the drainage system along Road R22; and
- Conflict between pedestrians and vehicular traffic.

Th aim of the improvement project is to alleviate congestion and to improve capacity and therefore the flow of traffic through town.

The contract is located on National Road R22 Section 5 from km 20.55 to km 24.42. The Contract falls within the Kwa-Zulu Natal Province and is situated within the Umkhanyakude District Municipality. The section of road runs through the town of KwaNgwanase situated within the Umhlabuyalingana Local Municipality.


The works involve the rehabilitation and widening of National Road R22 Section 5 through the town of KwaNgwanase. The contract also includes the construction of street lighting, new storm water systems and a 2.83 km bypass road (IYK Road) connecting with Road R22-5 at km 22.25 and km 25.00.

Other works included in the scope are the construction of access roads and pedestrian sidewalks as well as identification and relocation of services (Eskom and telephone poles and lines, water and sewer pipes, and other unknown underground services).

Instructions to Military Veteran Contractor:

- 1. The application forms must be completed in full
- 2. All the required and supporting documentation must be submitted jointly with this form.
- 3. Failure to submit supporting and requested information will lead to your company not being registered.
- 4. The required information on page 6 to 9 is an indication of what information is required for your business to be registered without delays.
- 5. Business registration and information sections on pages 6 to 8 are pre-requisites for registration and therefore must be completed in full. Failure to complete this section will lead to your business not being registered.
- 6. Declaration by business under oath on page 12 is compulsory and must be completed in full by all sub-contractors and suppliers. Failure to comply with this requirement will lead to your company not being registered.
- 7. The PLC reserves the right to validate all information supplied and any misrepresentation of facts may lead to disqualification and potentially being restricted to do business with other spheres of SANRAL and/or other organs of state.
- 8. A duly completed form together with supporting documentation must be emailed to the address indicated on page 2. The PLC will not accept faxed forms.

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3. REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- i. Proof that Applicant is registered as a Military Veteran;
- ii. Proof of company registration; CIPC Certificate indicating:
 - An Exempted Micro Enterprise (EME) or Qualified Small Enterprise
 (QSE) which is at least 51% owned by black people;
 - An EME or QSE which is at least 51% owned by black people who are youth;
 - An EME or QSE which is at least 51% owned by black people who are women;
 - An EME or QSE which is at least 51% owned by black people with disabilities;
 - An EME or QSE which is 51% owned by black people living in rural or underdeveloped areas or townships;
 - A cooperative which is at least 51% owned by black people;
 - An EME or QSE which is at least 51% owned by black people who are military veterans; or
 - More than one of the categories referred to above;
- iii. Tax clearance Pin number issued by SARS
- iv. CRS number issued by CIDB
- v. Proof of registration with the National Treasury Central Supplier Database (CSD)





- vi. Proof that the Applicant is compliant with the Compensation for Occupational Injuries and Diseases (COID) (not a requirement to be registered on database but will be required if awarded a tender)
- vii. Proof of address indicating that the applicant's business address. Provide utility bill, e.g. municipal water and lights account or property managing agent statement, bank statement or an official bank document or form. Municipal councilor's letter or Tax certificate, etc.
